PACE OF PLAY — A competitive round at BROWN DEER PARK should be completed in 4 hours and 14 minutes or less (MCPLA PACE RATING). BY ENTERING THIS TOURNAMENT, THE PLAYER SIGNIFIES HE IS CAPABLE AND WILLING TO PLAY AT THIS PACE. LOCAL RULE IS IN EFFECT PERMITTING THE USE OF DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES PER DECISION 14-3/0.5.

FORMAT — Competition will be 36 holes at stroke play to determine the 2009 County Champion and Flight Champions in the following classifications: Championship Flight - 4.6 "A" Flight 4.7 - 8.3 "B" Flight 8.4 - 12.7 "C" Flight 12.8 - 17.0 "D" Flight 17.1 & UP at full Handicap ENTRIES WILL DETERMINE FINAL FLIGHT RANGES. In the event of a tie for any of the above Championships, a hole-by-hole playoff will be held immediately upon completion of the final round.

ELIGIBILITY — The Tournament is open to Milwaukee County Public Links Association Members and any other adult male amateur golfer residing in Milwaukee County who holds a current USGA-WSGA Handicap Index. Preference will be given to Milwaukee County Public Links Association members.

TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS — U.S.G.A. Rules govern all play, unless amended by a local rule. Tournament Committee reserves the right to rule on all matters pertaining to the Tournament. FALSIFYING INFORMATION AND/OR IMPROPER CONDUCT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED, WITH DISQUALIFICATION AND POSSIBLE DISCIPLINARY ACTION RESULTING.

DRESS CODE — Shirts must have traditional collars; only golf slacks or knee length walking shorts allowed, NO DENIM. PLAYERS FAILING TO COMPLY WILL FORFEIT THE RIGHT TO COMPETE. Pagers, cell phones and metal or traditionally-designed spikes are prohibited. Penalty - DISQUALIFICATION.

DEADLINE — The field will close at 208 acceptable entries or at 5:00 P.M. on Friday, August 14, 2009 Late or incomplete entries will not be accepted.

PAIRINGS AND STARTING TIMES — Pairings will be made and players notified of starting times by mail. All competitors must play at the time specified by the Committee. CHAMPIONSHIP FLIGHT WILL BE RE-PAIRED SUNDAY ACCORDING TO SATURDAY SCORES.

CADDIES, CARTS AND SPECTATORS — Caddies, other than another competitor, are allowed. Players may use motor carts, when available; the committee will attempt to pair up riders. Spectators are welcome but are not permitted to give advice.

AWARDS — Plaques will be awarded to the County Champion and all Flight Champions, IMMEDIATELY UPON COMPLETION OF THEIR FINAL ROUND. Prizes (Gift Certificates) will be mailed to approximately 25% of field with the Tournament Results Letter within two weeks of Tournament close.
