The MCPLA May meeting was called to order by President Walker at 6:30pm. In attendance were 4 officers and 14 directors representing the following clubs:

- Treasurer's report: 6/1/09 balance of \$13,103.61; CAP portion is \$4,363.14 for a net balance of \$8,740.47. All dues have been paid except for Greenfield and Whitnall. Subsequent new members will be due Sept 1.
- Secretary's report: minutes accepted as mailed. Unfortunately, yours truly forgot to send out e-mail prior to the meeting.
- Club rosters: eight (8) printed copies were due at June meeting, only two clubs turned in, one club provided a single copy. Please turn in at July meeting.
- Senior and Mid-Am was held at Grant on May 16 & 17
 - VERY low turnout!
 - Mid-Am only 1 fight (27 entries)
 - Future of Mid-Am in jeopardy; if cancel, move Senior back to 50 and older.
 - Concern that members are playing in other events on same dates as County events. Why? Clubs are asked NOT to schedule events that conflict with MCPLA and WPLA events.
- Arnold Walker Championships at Brown Deer, Aug 29 & 30
 - App is posted on web site
- NIMAGA at Evergreen on September 19 – NEED PLAYERS!
 - Conflict has already been noted as Oakwood has scheduled a club event for the same day. WHY?? This is NOT an acceptable practice and should not be done.
- Workers Tournament at Brown Deer on October 11
- First 2nd Team match held on May 31st at Currie; Brown Deer wins with 257 points; pace was somewhat slow, approx 5 hours. Some concerns with course setup, played white tees but some in blue locations. #9 and #18 landing areas were difficult; long grass, wet conditions. Feeling that host club should have done a better job in setting up the course (including marking of course). Also discussion as to no enforcement of rules relating to dress code (i.e. blue jeans) and use of cell phone. Issue was apparently brought up but no action taken. All captains and director MUST enforce the rules.
- Discussion as to reasons for canceling first 2nd team match at Greenfield. Course was not closed, only issue was no carts allowed. Not in contract with County to cancel based on this condition. When was "no carts" actually known? Could clubs have been contacted and alternate players put into lineups.
